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## Essential Functions

- Makes repairs on engine components (gas and diesel) – lubrication systems, fueling systems, tune-ups, cooling systems, transmissions, etc.
- Makes repairs on the suspension and body
- Services and repairs air conditioning systems
- Able to troubleshoot all systems for defective parts
- Performs preventative and periodic maintenance inspections
- Finds instructions and parts in maintenance and parts manuals for related systems
- Inspects and repairs wheelchair lifts
- Maximizes efficient use of vehicle repair parts
- Ability to repair electrical and mechanical components, major and minor, without the need of any supervision
- Ability to follow safety precautions
- Ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with management, employees, and the public
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals
- Ability to write routine reports and correspondence
- Ability to perform basic math calculations including, but not limited to, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and units of measure
- Ability to understand and carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form
- Available to work occasional overtime
- Ability to work designated shifts and all days of the year including holidays
