Denton County Transportation Authority Announces 2015 State Fair Travel Schedule

Agency encourages passengers to utilize online State Fair toolkit for trip planning help

Lewisville, TX (September 21, 2015) – The Denton County Transportation Authority (DCTA) will run expanded A-train service every Saturday during the State Fair so riders can have more times to choose from for their trip planning needs. All other DCTA services will operate as scheduled. DCTA's 2015 State Fair schedule is now available to view at <u>www.RideDCTA.net</u>. In addition, passengers can pick up the agency's print brochure with the State Fair schedule at the Euline Brock Downtown Denton Transit Center (DDTC).

Fair goers can ride DCTA and avoid the hassle of traffic and parking. With five convenient A-train stations and more than 30 Connect bus stops throughout Denton County, DCTA is an easy and convenient way to head to the State Fair of Texas. Passengers can ride DCTA to the Trinity Mills Station and connect to the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Green Line all the way to Big Tex!

Don't forget DCTA's helpful tips for travel to and from the State Fair of Texas:

- **Plan Ahead** Visit RideDCTA.net and plan your entire trip online from start to finish.
- Go Paperless Opt to purchase your regional fare pass on the GoPass[™] app straight from your phone. Tickets are also available online and at DCTA locations.
- Arrive Early It's always helpful to get to your bus stop or A-train station at least 10 minutes before your scheduled departure.
- Have Fun Let DCTA be your ride to the rides this year and let your inner child run free!
