









We have a long way to go. Did you know that Texas is the second largest state in the United States?




There are lots of ways we can travel.

We will ride in a car for part of the trip. But we want to make sure the car we ride in is clean and well taken care of.





Cars that aren't cared for can make the air dirty. Dirty air is called pollution. We need clean air to stay healthy.





Color the pictures of Texas symbols. These are some of the plants and animals you will find in our state.







We want to do our part to keep the air clean. If we keep our cars in good shape we can help make a difference.




How else can we ride? We can go in a bus, a train or on a plane. We can also carpool with friends.

You can also do your part by asking one of the drivers in your family how they take care of your car. Cars need to be looked after to work and be clean.




And ask them to drive smart. Don't go too fast. It's not safe. And driving fast uses more gas.


