University Pass Program

The University Pass Program offers annual and semester-long passes at a discounted rate to UNT students, faculty and staff, providing an affordable and convenient alternative for commuters.



MedPark Station Park & Ride

Park for free at Denton's MedPark station and take the Colorado Express bus directly to campus. You can also ride the A-train for free from the MedPark station to the Downtown Denton Transit Center as part of DCTA's "Free Fare Zones" promotion.



Late-Night Lyft Service

DCTA partners with Lyft to provide safe, reliable and complimentary after-hours service between 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. to students, faculty and staff traveling within the specified UNT Lyft Zone. To utilize the service, you must enter the promo code provided by UNT, which is updated each semester.



Go with GoZone

GoZone, DCTA's on-demand rideshare service, picks you up at a "virtual" bus stop near your location. Commute or get around Denton, Highland Village and Lewisville with limited wait times.

GoZone operates seven days a week and has a base cost of \$1.50 per ride. When booking rides on the app, it will tell you if it's better to take GoZone or a bus.
