## **A-TRAIN COMMUTER RAIL**

Our 21-mile commuter rail line connects passengers to the Dallas Area Rapid Transit's (DART) Green Line in Carrollton, where riders can transfer to other DART services and the Trinity Railway Express (TRE) for travel into Fort Worth.



# CONNECT BUS

DCTA provides fixed-route bus service in Denton and Lewisville to help you get from Point A to Point B. Connect Service offers convenient destinations and stops at all of our A-train stations.

# **CONNECT SHUTTLE**

This peak-period shuttle service travels within a designated Highland Village Zone, taking residents and visitors to highdensity locations within the zone and connecting points with other DCTA services.

## **ACCESS SERVICE**

#### **COMMUNITY ON-DEMAND**

In conjunction with Connect Shuttle, DCTA offers curb-to-curb bus trips within the designated Highland Village Zone to give riders the flexibility to go where life takes them.

#### **FRISCO DEMAND-RESPONSE**

DCTA provides curb-to-curb demand-response transit service for eligible passengers for trips originating within Frisco's incorporated limits to destinations located in Frisco, McKinney, and Allen.



#### CAMPUS CONNECTIONS

DCTA partners with the University of North Texas and North Central Texas College to provide campus shuttle services, which connect riders to each campus and to other DCTA services.

# DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT (DART) GREEN LINE

The A-train connects with DART's Green Line at the Trinity Mills Station in Carrollton. Passengers can reach destinations served by DART, TRE, and the Fort Worth Transportation Authority (FWTA) from the Green Line. Regional fare is required to transfer between DCTA and our regional partners, but passengers disembarking at Trinity Mills without transfer only need DCTA local fare.

## FORT WORTH / ALLIANCE / DENTON EXPRESS

Effective September 26, 2016, FWTA will provide weekday express bus service between Fort Worth and Denton along Interstate 35W. For park and ride locations and schedule information, please visit fwta.org.
