## **FARE INFORMATION**

## **DCTA LOCAL FARE:**

Valid on the A-train, Denton and Lewisville Connect, Highland Village Connect Shuttle, North Texas Xpress (between Denton and Alliance), UNT Campus Shuttle, Denton Airport Zone, Lewisville Lakeway Zone and NCTC Campus Shuttle. Excludes Access, Frisco Demand-Response, Frisco AV and Collin County Transit.

### **REGIONAL SYSTEM FARE:**

Valid on the A-train, Denton and Lewisville Connect, Highland Village Connect Shuttle, North Texas Xpress (between Denton and downtown Fort Worth), UNT Campus Shuttle, Denton Airport Zone, Lewisville Lakeway Zone and NCTC Campus Shuttle. Required for trips taken outside of the DCTA service area. Includes access to fixed-route bus and rail services operated by DART, TRE and Trinity Metro. Excludes Access service, Frisco Demand-Response, Frisco AV and Collin County Transit services as well as DART and Trinity Metro paratransit services.

## **REDUCED FARE:**

Seniors (65+), persons with disabilities, Medicare cardholders and students (ages 5 through 18); students over the age of 14 require a valid high school or DCTA-issued ID.



## **FREE FARES:**

Complimentary transportation is available for those who meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Sworn peace officer in uniform or with a visible
- Children under five with a fare-paying adult
- Denton County active jurors with a valid juror summons or current juror badge
- ADA-certified riders with valid IDs (excluding
- NCTC IDs accepted on NCTC Campus Shuttle, Highland Village Connect Shuttle and Denton and Lewisville Connect in lieu of fare
- UNT IDs accepted on UNT Campus Shuttle, Highland Village Connect Shuttle and Denton and Lewisville Connect in lieu of fare
- · Passes are not required for people traveling between the DDTC and MedPark Stations or between the Hebron and Trinity Mills Stations (local fare is still required on the A-train when traveling outside of the Free Fare Zones).


