EASY STEPS TO RIDE CONNECT BUS & A-TRAIN

1 PLAN YOUR TRIP

Visit **RideDCTA.net** or use our Go Guide to plan your trip. Start with where you want to go and when you need to get there, then work backward to determine your departure time.

2 BUY YOUR FARE

Determine what type of pass you need and for how long you will need it. **HINT:** Local passes only work on DCTA, whereas regional passes work on DCTA, DART, the T and the TRE.

Purchase your ticket on the GoPassSM mobile app, at **RideDCTA.net**, at a DCTA ticket outlet, via a ticket vending machine located on the A-train platforms, or with exact cash from the electronic fare box inside the bus.

3 FIND YOUR RIDE

Arrive at least five minutes before your departure time. Have your ticket ready and always check the route number and destination sign on the front of the vehicle.

4 RIDE YOUR ROUTE

Always wait for the vehicle to come to a complete stop before boarding or exiting. Follow all posted instructions. On the bus, use the “stop request cord” about a block from your destination to tell the operator you would like to exit.

5 NEED TO TRANSFER?

If you need to transfer to another route or service to get to your final destination, make sure you coordinate the entire length of your trip at the start for a seamless travel experience.
